# POULTRY SECTION

---

**Please read all rules and regulations carefully before entering.**

**ENTRY FEES:**

1. Pigeons, bantam poultry N\$3,45 per entry (VAT included) per entry.
2. Big Poultry: N\$5,75 (VAT included) per entry.

**CLOSING DATE:**

1. Entries close on Friday, All classes: **1<sup>st</sup> of September 2006**
2. No late entries will be accepted.
3. No entries should be done on the correct entry form – entry fees included.
4. No telephonic entries will be accepted.

**JUDGING:**

1. Judging will take place under supervision of the Committee, by qualified judges appointed by the Show Society.
2. Judges decisions are final.
3. Dates(s) on which judging will take place as well as names of the judges will be announced later.

**PRIZE AND PRIZE-GIVING:**

Prizes to section winners in separate classes will be awarded according to the opinion of the Committee. Place and date of prize giving will be announced later.

**RULES OF THE SHOW:**

1. The Show will be open to the whole of Namibia, the Republic of S.A. and Zimbabwe. Exhibitors from the Republic must abide by the Veterinary import regulations currently applicable.
2. Completed Entry forms accompanied by the correct entry fees must reach the Livestock Co-ordinator on or before the specified closing date by mail to address: P.O. Box 1733, Windhoek or delivered at the Show Office, Show Grounds (Tel 224748). No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. All remittances to be made payable to the “Windhoek Show Society”. No telephonic entries will be accepted.

3. Entries are not subject to cancellation.
4. Pigeons – Entries without a year ring can only be entered in open classes. Pens will be numbered according to the year ring.
5. The Committee reserves to itself the right to alter or combine any classes should they consider that the number of entries in these classes warrant such action.
6. Breeders' cards may be attached to the pens containing their birds after the completion of judging.
7. During the Show the exhibits will be in the custody of the Committee and may not be touched or handled by the exhibitor or any unauthorized person. Exhibits will be fed, watered and attended to and every possible care will be taken, but the Society / Committee will not accept any responsibility for losses which might occur.
8. Unhealthy birds will not be exhibited but will immediately be returned to the owner and entry fees will be forfeited.
9. Pens will be provided by the Committee.
10. Exhibitors who intend to sell poultry or pigeons are requested to advise the Committee in good time. Awards will appear on cards attached to the pens.
11. Judges decisions are final.
12. Judges are authorized not to award prizes in any class, should the standard not meet with their approval.
13. All entries should be the property of the exhibitors, and should have been in their possession for at least 3 months.
14. Incorrect entries or entries which do not comply with the Society's Rules and Regulations are liable to disqualification. Entry fees will not be refunded.
15. The Committee reserves the right to restrict entries in the various classes according to available space.
16. Poultry and Pigeons may not be removed from the Show Grounds before a specific time, which will be announced later.
